Friends and Family of Forest Hills,

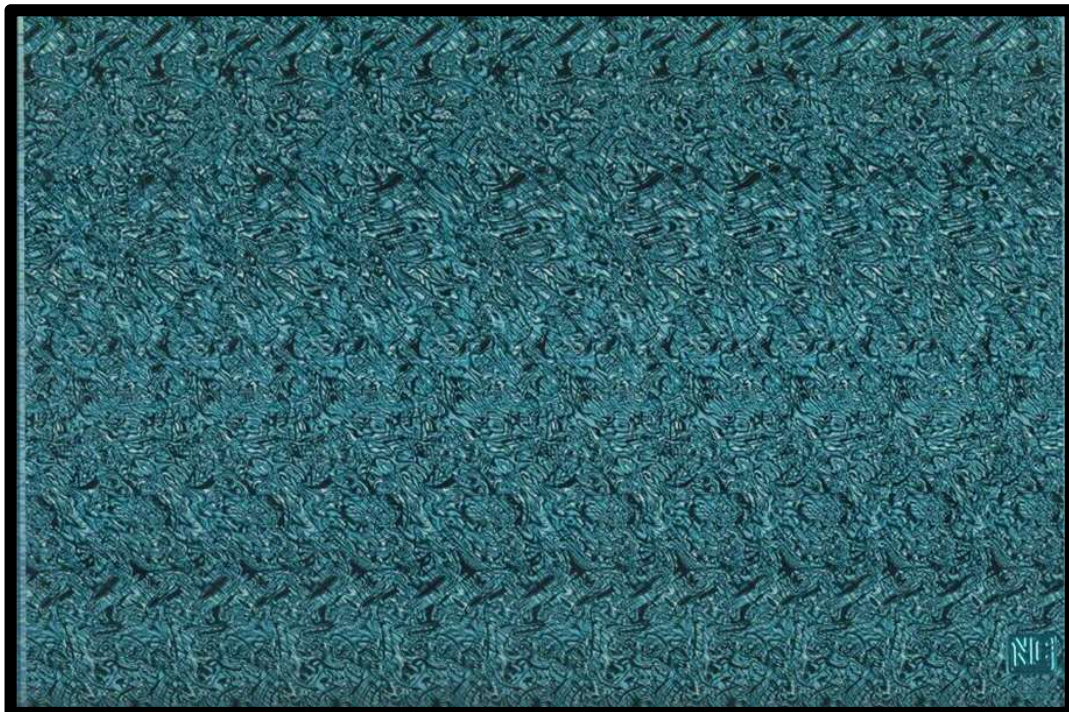
