As I was watching TV the other day, there was a commercial for a daytime talk show where the host was giving away a different gift to her audience for 12 consecutive days. When they interviewed the host for the promo spot, she jokingly said, "Christmas isn't about how much you spend on other people. It's about how much they spend on you." The audience got a good laugh, because I'm sure that's not what they expected her to say.

Reflecting on that comment, I initially viewed it as part of the commercialization of Christmas. Stores are busy, vendors are gaining a lot of profit through higher sales, and people are buying lots of 'stuff' for others in their lives. My initial thought was that we know as Christians, that Christmas isn't about how much you spend, nor is it about how much others spend on you. It's about Jesus. But as I continued to reflect on this host's comment, I realized there may actually be a glimmer of truth in what she's saying.

Christmas is indeed in fact about how much someone spent on you. That someone is God the Father. He sent His one and only Son to come to Earth as a baby. He knew what Jesus would face during His time here on Earth. He knew about the persecution, the mocking, the insults, and even the death that Jesus would face. He knew that the joy of Christmas would turn to the sorrow of Good Friday; but He also knew that it would turn back to joy on Easter Sunday. In essence, Christmas is all about what God spent on you – He picked up the cost of our sin by giving us His Son – and there were no sales on this gift – no coupons, no shortcuts. When Jesus died for you and me, when He rose again, our invoice reads, "PAID IN FULL!"

During this holiday season, we give gifts as a reminder of the gift that God gave us. It is actually fun to go and enjoy the holiday spirit in churches, homes, and yes, even shopping malls. It's fun to deck the halls and jingle the bells. It's fun to get into the spirit of things. Yet the true fun, the true meaning of the season is reflecting on my Savior and yours entering this world as the Babe of Bethlehem. I pray that as you prepare for the coming Christmas, that you would be able to ponder the meaning of Christmas – the amount that God spent on you so that you could have and enjoy real life.


