



Remote Learning Standards Addendum for Middle School Grades

Students in Middle School have had experience in the structure and routine of school and require these critical years to prepare themselves for academic adventures in High School. While engaging in remote learning, the expectations of middle school students are higher. They are encouraged to create a learning space in their home that is dedicated to remote learning. Creating this space will set the tone for instruction and help in organizing their supplies and other learning needs.

The goal for Middle School students during remote learning is to provide as close to a regular schedule as possible, and to hold students accountable to learning and assignment completion. In order to facilitate that, Middle School students will have a five block schedule that will begin each morning at 8am and run through 1pm, with the exception of the days where they physically come to school. On those days, the instruction will end at noon in order to provide them the time they need to arrive on campus.

Each of the five blocks will contain up to an hour of instruction in a core subject area. ***Teachers will end the blocks with sufficient time for students to take a short break and prepare for their next subject.***

The schedule is as follows:

Teachers will end the blocks with sufficient time for students to take a short break and prepare for their next subject.

On each day of remote learning, students will have a block of Christian Studies, Math, Language Arts, and Science. On Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, a block of Social Studies is added to the schedule. Students will be provided with their specific schedule by their homeroom teacher. Students will be provided with a two-hour in person instruction block on either Tuesdays or Thursdays between 1pm-3pm. During that time frame, students will see all three homeroom teachers during that block.
