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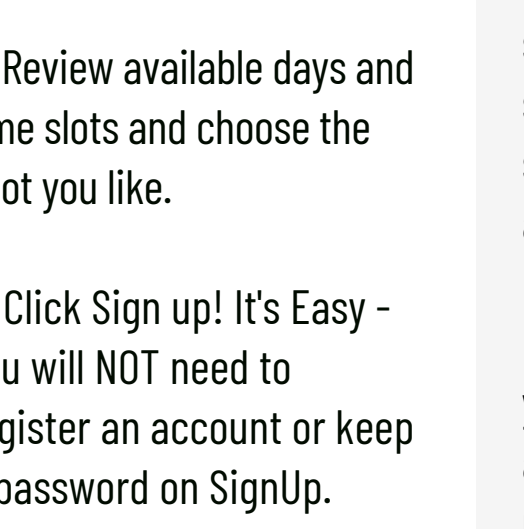

a letter from the principal

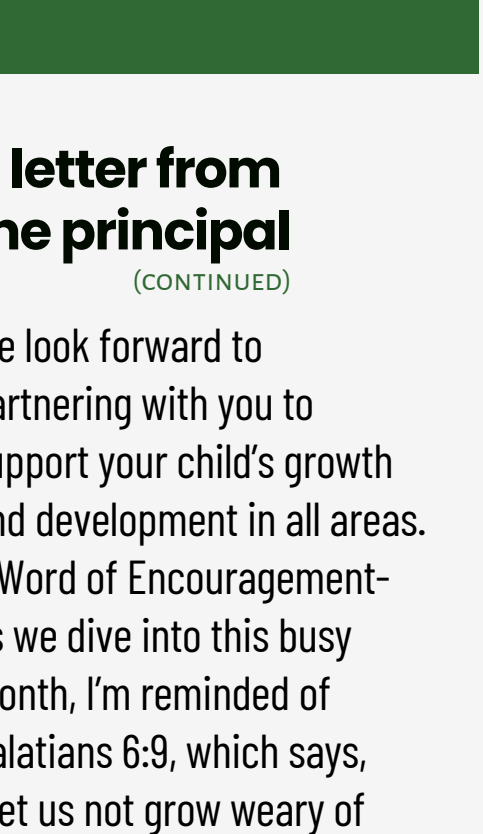

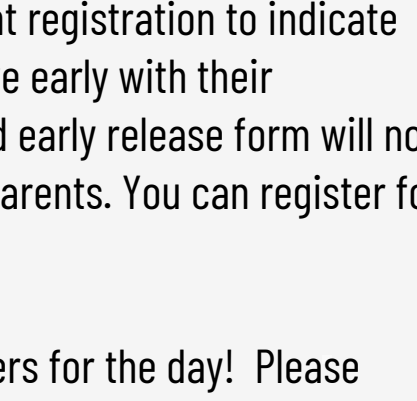
Stickers were handed out to students in celebration of our 1st Falcon Friday!

grandparents day important info

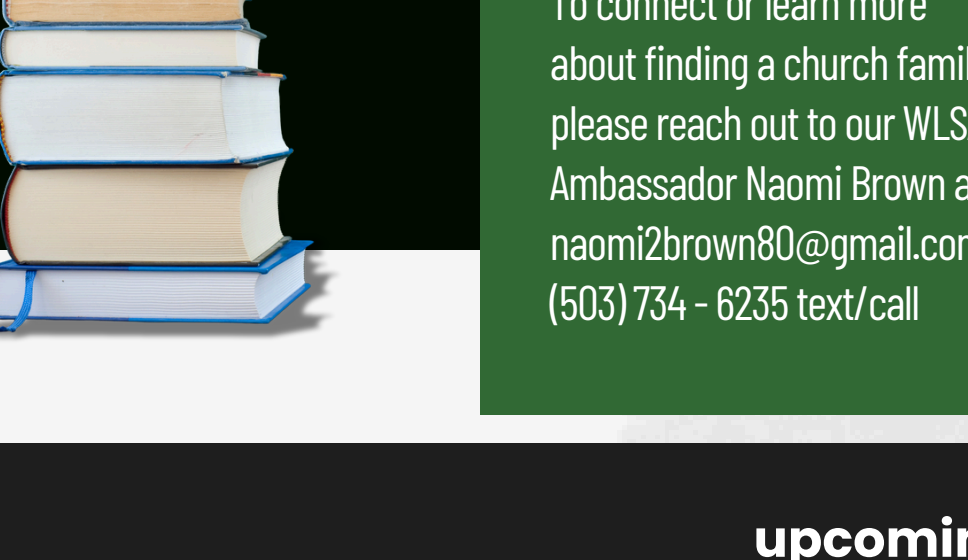
Grandparents Day is Friday, October 4, from 12:00 to 2:30pm.

It's almost here and we're so excited to have you be a part of this special day! In preparation for the event, please review the following FAQ:

When should I arrive?

We will begin checking in all visitors starting at noon. Visitors will not be permitted into the building prior to 12 PM.

Where can I park?



Do I need to register for this event?

Yes, please. If you have not done so, please visit the event registration [HERE](#). At check-in we will have two lines, one for pre-registered guests and one for those who need to register.

Once I'm checked-in where do I go?

After you're checked in, please make your way to the gym. We'll have signs and volunteers to guide you along the way! Once at the gym be sure to sit in the section that corresponds with your grandchild's grade.

What should I do if I have multiple grandchildren at Forest Hills?

Students can travel in groups with siblings and grandparents, making sure to visit all the classrooms. Grandparents can also be divided between students if there are enough to go around to make it a more of an individualized experience.

What can I expect during the event?

After the gym assembly, grandparents will be invited to explore the campus with their grandchildren. Be sure to follow the scavenger hunt paper and visit all the stops.
