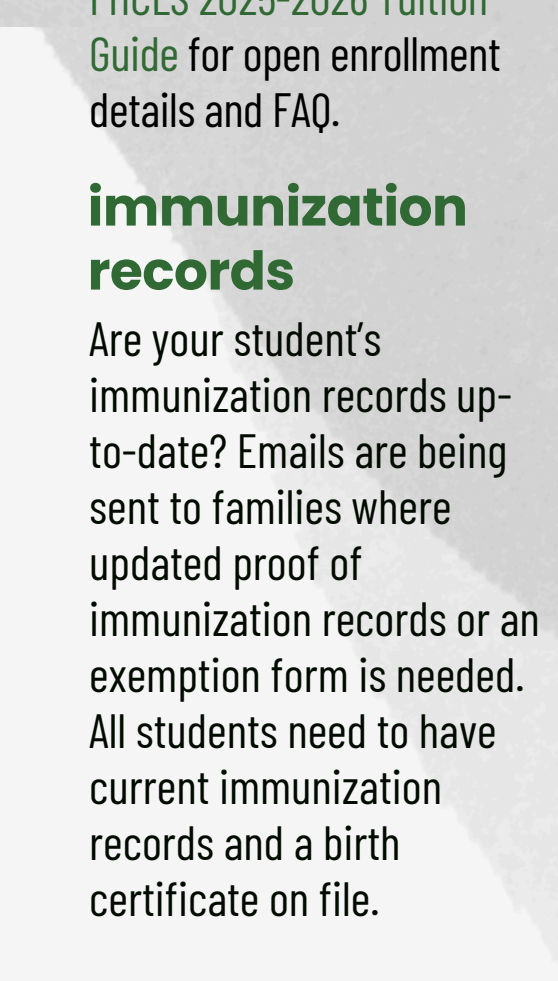

**reenrollment is underway**

The 2025-2026 FHLCS Tuition Schedule is out and open enrollment starts Jan 8th.

Open enrollment is the time to confirm your current student's 2025-2026 spot and ensure we have the most up-to-date information for your household.

Does it matter when I re-enroll? Jan 8th through Jan 22nd is priority enrollment for current students, and spots become open to new students Jan 23rd. Several classes are expected to be full. If re-enrollment is not completed by Jan 22nd, it's possible your student could lose their spot. Past due TADS accounts cannot re-enroll until they're brought current.



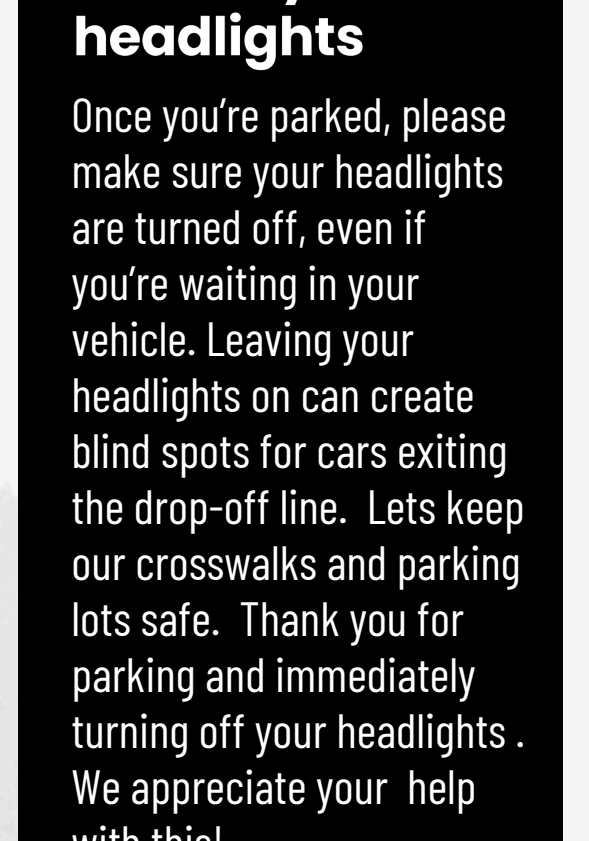

**immunization records**

Are your student's immunization records up-to-date? Emails are being sent to families where updated proof of immunization records or an exemption form is needed. All students need to have current immunization records and a birth certificate on file.

If you have received a request for a birth certificate or immunization record, please provide the requested documentation as soon as possible. Students without the necessary records on file by Feb 19th, will be ineligible to attend school.
