Please send your student with sunscreen and a water bottle, it's going to be a hot one!

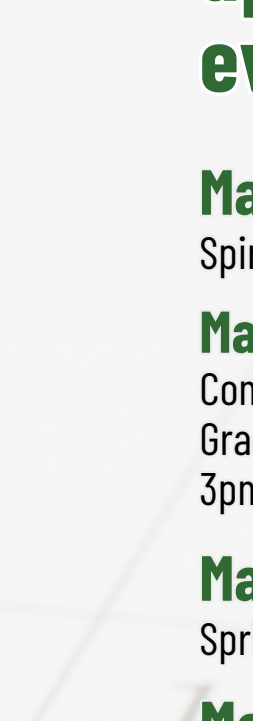
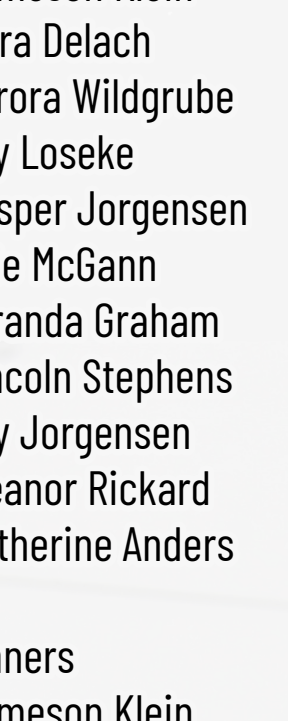
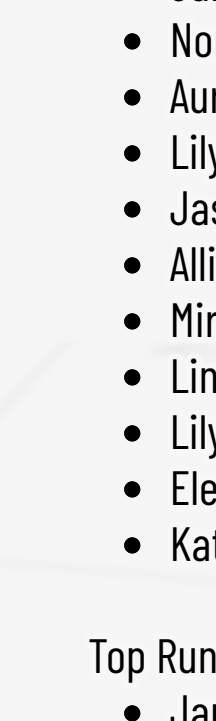
